

Special City Council Meeting –
October 31, 2018

The City Council of Watford City met on October 31, 2018 at 12:00 P.M. at City Hall. Present were Mayor Phil Riely (via phone), and Council Members Bethany Devlin, Kenny Liebel, and Lindsay Wingerter. Absent was Matt Beard, Aaron Gravos, and Steve Sanford. Also present was City Planner Curt Moen, City Auditor Peni Peterson, and City Attorney Wyatt Voll.

Council Member Liebel moved to approve an Escrow Agreement between Hunters Run, LLC, American Landmark Homes, City of Watford City, and First National Bank & Trust Co. This agreement is to provide a source of funds to pay for the Roadway Improvements located in the Hunters Run Subdivision.
